An annulment is not a "Catholic divorce," rather it is an investigation to determine if from the beginning the marriage was invalid. The Catholic Church holds all marriages to be sacred and permanent; unless the marriage was unlawful (Matthew 19). A Declaration of Nullity (annulment) takes approximately a year to complete, so it may delay your ability to enter the Church.]
