We have been providing you many ways to stay connected to our parish for many years now. In this time of pandemic, it is more important than ever to stay connected. We enable you to engage your parish, even if you cannot be here, and faith in all aspects of your life with updates of Mass schedules, daily readings, prayers, sacraments and devotions, youth and adult education, social activities... and more.

The following vehicles of communication are several ways to stay tuned in with the happenings in our church and ways to continue your faith formation.

- **Web Site**, visit our updated Saint Ann Parish web site at www.saintannparish.org. You can watch Mass as a Live-Stream at the scheduled Mass times (see updated times) or at your convenience with On-demand thru the Previous Broadcast option. Just Click on the **Live Stream button** on the home page and you will see two video choices. The one on the left is for Masses. If you tune in during the regularly scheduled Mass time, just click on the play arrow. If it is not a live stream, click on Previous Broadcast and you will see all the previous Masses and you can choose the one you want to watch. The video choice on the right has the many Mass+... presentations and the religious education, like the current "Mark" sessions, recordings that have been completed. Click on the one you want and enjoy.
- **Parish App**, go to your "Smart Phone's" app store and download "My Parish App". On your downloaded app search for "St. Ann Catholic Church" and upload to your phone. **OR** Text **APP** to **88202** to download "My Parish App" and search for "St Ann Catholic Church." You will find many options like the Daily Readings, Saint of the Day, Bishop Barron and many more. Live Streaming of Mass is now available!
- **Flock Notes**, sign up for regular email or text reminders, or Flock Notes, by going to www.saintannparish.org and clicking the "Flocknote" icon on the home page. We are using Flock Notes as an important part of keeping you updated with how the changes affect us. You will have the choice of receiving your updates via email or text.
- **Social Media**, see regular posts of Saint Ann parish life, educational opportunities, events and updated activities by going to our Facebook page (St. Ann Catholic Church Cincinnati, Santa Ana Iglesias Catholic) and Instagram Account (stanncommunitygroesbeck).
- **FORMED**, (*Catholic Netflix*) provided free, features Catholic videos, audio talks and eBooks. Sign up by going to www.saintannparish.org, click the "FORMED" icon and follow the prompts.
- **On-line Giving**, we have many people ask us how can they continue their financial support of the parish during this time of no public Masses? You can simply set up an On-line Giving account. Go to the website (www.saintannparish.org) and click on the Giving button. Follow the instructions on the page and you are set. Thank you for considering this option since it has many benefits for you and the parish. And yes, you can still support all your favorite special funds thru On-line Giving. No envelopes to worry about, meet your giving goals, helps setting parish budgets, set up thru your bank of credit card (we do not see the account info), saves the parish money (no envelopes and mailing cost) and many more benefits.
